# Dementia for Scientists

The curriculum, now available on YouTube, is designed for junior investigators or faculty looking to expand their knowledge of the dementias and dementia-related research. Dementia research is highly diverse in content, ranging from basic biophysical research to social science. While investigators entering the field from diverse research backgrounds are well-trained in their own discipline, they may lack broader knowledge of the many aspects of dementia and dementia research that are important in understanding critical issues in the field. This curriculum aims to provide a relatively sophisticated introduction to critical aspects of dementias across the diversity of the field.
